

## **2020-21 K-12 Mandatory Immunizations and Athletic Physical Information**

Dear Parents,

### **K-12 MANDATORY IMMUNIZATIONS**

According to the Ohio Department of Health, all incoming Kindergarten, 7th and 12th graders will need to show proof of having received the age appropriate vaccines before the first day of school this fall.

**KINDERGARTEN-5 Dtap, 4 Polio, 3 Hepatitis B, 2 MMR, and 2 Varicella**

**7TH GRADE- 1 Dtap booster and 1 Meningitis vaccine within the past two years**

**12TH GRADE-1 additional Meningitis booster with the past one year.**

**This year we are pleased to announce that ONU Healthwise has partnered with the Hardin County Health Department and the ONU mobile bus is coming to Ada Schools to administer the appropriate vaccines to students with private or Ohio government insurance coverage for vaccines. The scheduled clinic date will be Tuesday, August 11, 2020 from 2-4 pm.** This will be “drive through style”, so there will be no scheduled appointment times. Paperwork is available on the Ada School home page.

Pre-registration for this ONU clinic is mandatory. All billing must be completed in advance so no walk ins will be taken. All students under the age of 18 must have a parent present, all students must be pre-registered and be fever free due to Covid-19 restrictions.

This is just one option to get your child’s immunizations completed. Many private medical professionals as well as the Ada Rite Aid Pharmacy are able to provide most of the vaccines.

If your child does not receive the vaccines needed at the Ada/ONU Clinic on August 11, you must provide a copy of your child’s vaccine dates to the appropriate Ada School office this upcoming fall yourself. If your child has received the mandatory vaccines already, you may provide a copy of the immunization record at any time to the school.
